



Club Rules for Children Attending the Club

Cabana Club members who are at least 12 years old, or entering 7th grade, may attend the pool without their parent or guardian if a signed permission slip is on file and the child has passed the club's swim test.

- Sign in when you arrive at the club. If you are under 16 years old, you cannot bring siblings who are under 12 years old or non-members to the club.
- Cooperate with lifeguards at all time and without question. Do not socialize with or distract the lifeguards.
- Bad language, roughhousing, and dangerous or disrespectful behavior will result in a lifeguard or board member telling you to leave the club immediately.
- Swimwear is required in the pool. Cut-offs, sportswear (including basketball shorts) and other street clothes are not permitted.
- Do not run on the concrete. Do not play in the clubhouse or kitchen area. Do not bike ride, skateboard, or roller skate on the club grounds.
- Keep food on the grass. Do not eat food or drinks that belong to others or to the club. This includes the Otter Pops the lifeguards have for the swim lesson students.
- Do not enter the pool equipment room.
- Radio and music volume must not disturb others.
- Keep the bathrooms clean. Do not waste toilet paper, paper towels, soap etc.
- Clean up your area before you leave. Return chairs and put all trash and recyclables in the receptacles.
- Do not grab, hang on to, or play with the volleyball and ping pong table nets.
- Do not bring pets to the club.
- Do not bring water balloons, squirting toys, or balls not designed for water play to the club. Pool toys that are 12" or smaller are permitted if they do not interfere with the other swimmers.



Greenhaven Cabana Club South Swimming Pool Permission Form

Children of Cabana Club members who are at least 12 years old or who are entering the 7th grade may be at the club and swim in the pool without their parent/legal guardian if they have passed a swimming test administered by a Greenhaven Cabana Club South lifeguard and has a signed permission slip on file. If misbehavior occurs or lifeguard instructions are not followed, the lifeguard and club's Board of Directors may revoke this privilege.

I understand that if he/she does not adhere to the Club rules and follow lifeguard instructions, he/she will not be able to attend the Club without an adult. If my child is in need of emergency medical treatment, I authorize the lifeguards and/or other responsible adult to seek immediate attention for my child by calling the appropriate emergency services. I also understand every effort will be made to contact me. I shall be responsible for medical and/or emergency expenses resulting from my child's accident or illness.
